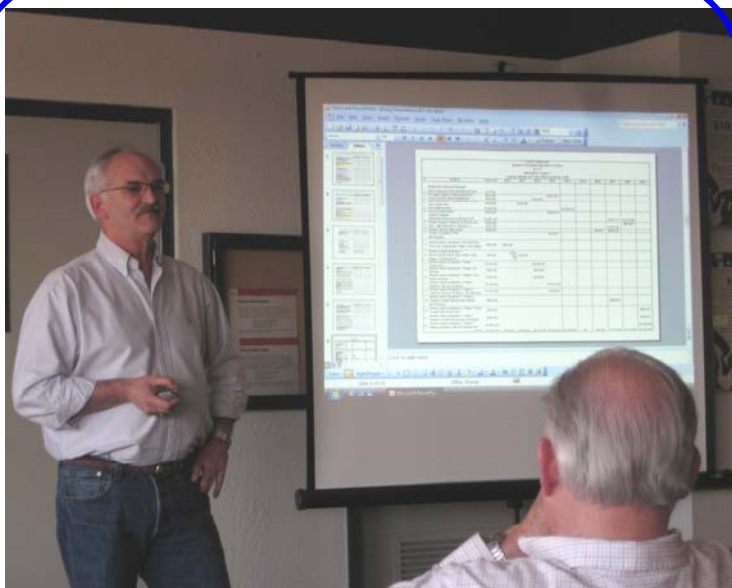

At Our Last CCPA Meeting . . .

Carl Sandau, KCLM manager, explained that like many small airports, Port Angeles will lose approximately \$1,000,000 if we can't increase enplanements on Kenmore flights leaving our airport. If ridership on Kenmore doesn't increase soon, we will not get the necessary 10,000 passengers by the end of 2011 required for entitlement to certain FAA funds. This means we will waive our designation as having an essential air service.

Once regional air service is lost, reestablishing it is extremely difficult. Is there anything CCPA can do to encourage more folks to use Kenmore?

## At Our Next Meeting

The Loomis Tavern is now situated at Lincoln Park. It is a very historic landmark and was once located on Hwy 101 East in the same block as Safeway. It has quite a history, some of which is a bit tawdry. 50 years ago everyone in town knew where the Loomis tavern was located. Everyone also knew about its large, famous wooden carving of a third finger salute that was obnoxiously displayed in plain sight of anyone passing through Port

Angeles. It was a great tourist attraction during the time that logging was king. However, anyone who knows anything about log structures also knows that the Loomis Tavern is a superb example of log construction. When the building was scheduled for demolition to make way for other businesses, there was quite an outcry. Finally the building was meticulously taken apart, log by log and moved to Lincoln Park.



So come to our next meeting. Bring a dish for the potluck. CCPA will provide the cook, rolls, drinks, condiments, table service, etc. for a great hamburger barbecue. Bring your spouse and a friend. PPS Do you know how to get to the Loomis Tavern? As you leave the airport (KCLM) turn left on Lauridsen Blvd and travel east for about three blocks to the LINCOLN PARK GROCERY. The entrance to Lincoln Park is opposite the grocery on the north side of Lauridsen. The Loomis Tavern is about 250 feet NE of the Park entrance.

When he realized that about 70 folks were already there, he almost turned around. However, when his daughter greeted him followed by his wife, he started to look at things a bit differently.**

**Jerry received a different type of birthday present. He received the Charles Taylor Master Mechanic award. Charles Taylor was supposedly the first aviation mechanic recognized by the FAA. This award has been given to about 1550 folks since its inception in 1958. Jerry was nominated for this award by Craig Gottshalk and presented to him by Patrick Paden, FAA Safety Inspector.**



**Jerry earned his private pilots license in 1961, power plant mechanic's license and airframe rating in 1962. In 1962 he started his own business, Weiler's Aircraft Maintenance at KCLM.**

**According to Paden, "His knowledge of FAA regulations, procedures, acceptable methods and practices pertaining to aircraft maintenance gained over more than 50 years is truly remarkable."**

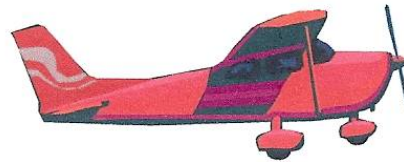

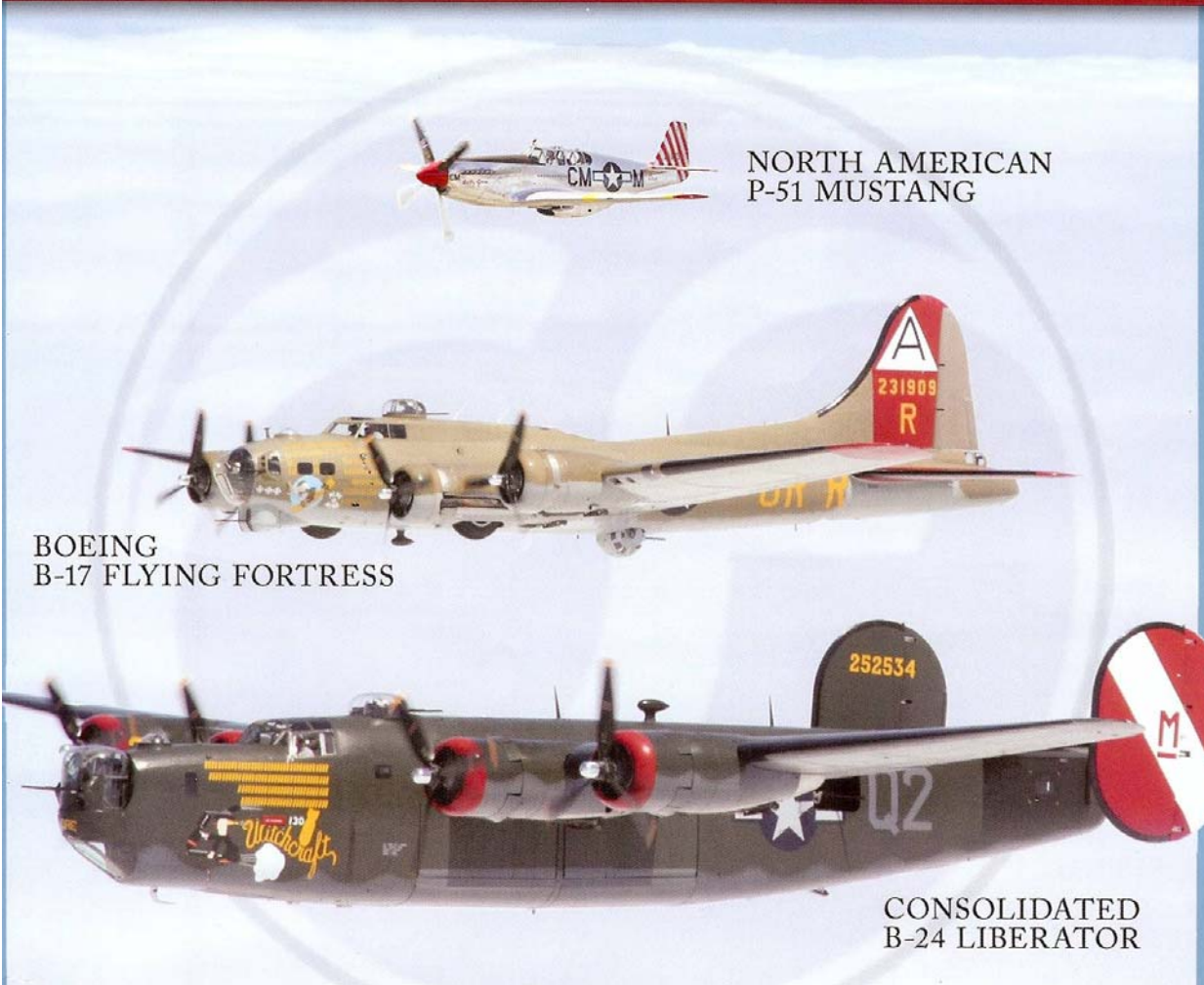
