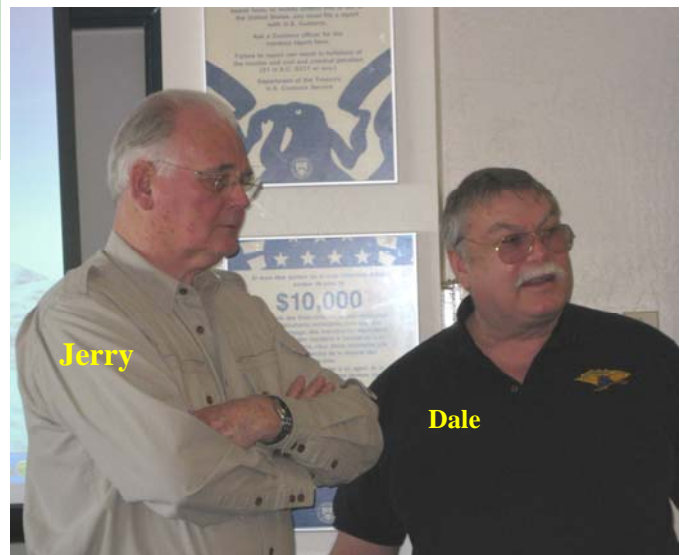

Dale stressed the need to prepare for just about any emergency in an area where the flying season is short and often further shortened by sudden weather changes. Since it may be a long time before anyone comes looking for you, it is necessary to think "survival". Is the plane you're flying in equipped with a 406 Mhz ELT? Do you have



a personal locator like a Spot Tracker? More than anything else drinking water and a way to stay warm are essential for survival. Dale, himself experienced an engine out emergency, but by keeping track of where he was, he managed to land in a lake right at the shoreline and close to a road where help could be obtained. **We hear from Alan Barnard . . . . .**

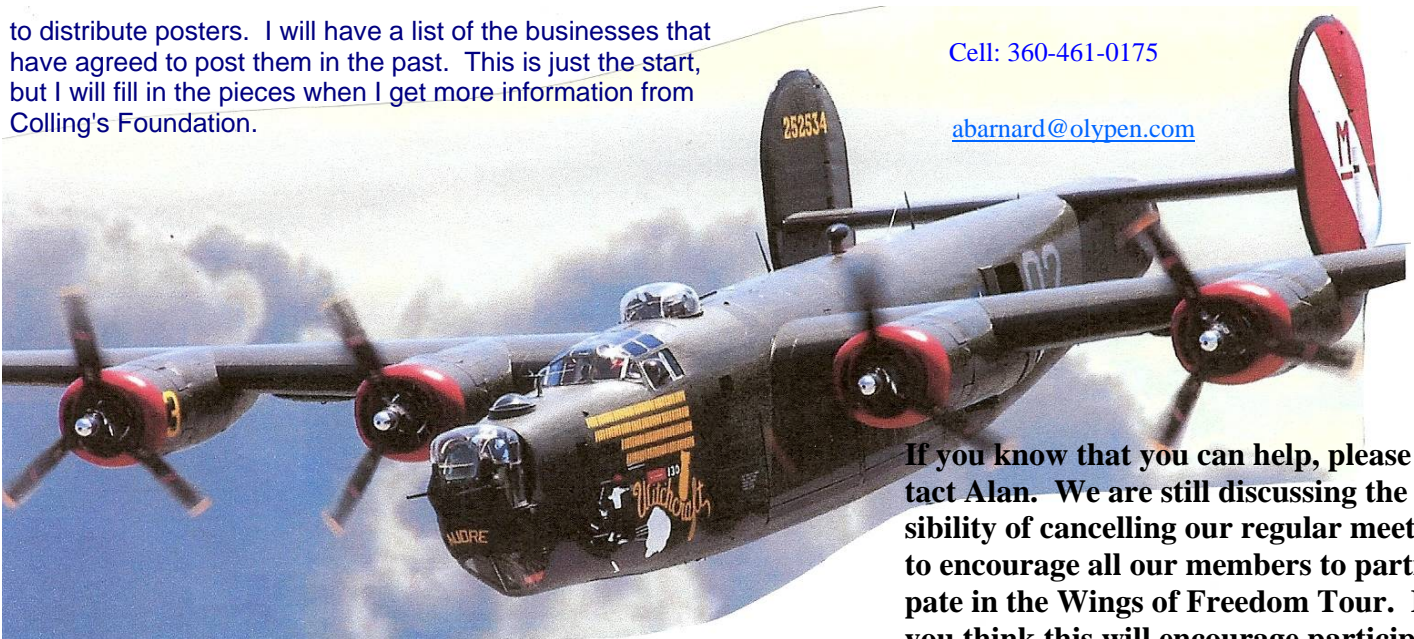
