The WPA sponsors several events to help you retain and advance your piloting skills. The Association organizes programs, workshops and clinics on aircraft maintenance and pilot proficiency including the FAA WINGS program. The WPA's annual Mountain Flying Clinic, for example, is a big hit enabling pilots to more safely enjoy flying in the beautiful but rugged Pacific Northwest areas.

Joining the WPA also includes you in Washington Air Search and Rescue (WASAR). The WPA formed WASAR in 1993 as an all-volunteer, non-profit corporation to support air search and rescue activities directed by the State. The WPA sponsors pilot training and observer training for non-pilots who want to participate in this valuable service to Washington citizens.

HEARD**

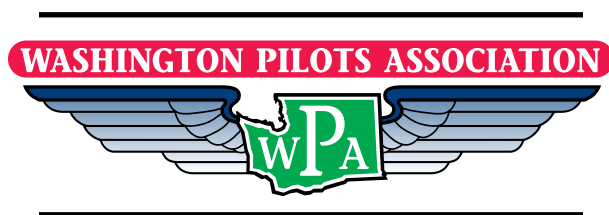
As we marvel at the advancements continually made in aviation, we must also be wary of the forces, such as new land development or changing public policy, that threaten aviation in our state.

WPA makes certain that GA is represented at meetings and hearings when our interests are at stake. Members are alerted by phone, fax and email, and interested participants are found who are available to represent the membership.



The organization also helps protect airports and air-space by actively working with Federal, State and local government. When appropriate members are given the information they need to take action in the form of letters or attendance at public meetings.

Chapter newsletters keep members informed of local events. WINGS, the bi-monthly newspaper of the WPA, is the most effective way the WPA keeps pilots informed statewide.
