



Name of Scholarship: WPA Southwest Chapter Scholarship, 2022

Amount of Scholarship: up to \$3,000.00 per person

Application Due Date: March 15, 2022

Award Announcement: April 1, 2022

Brief Description: To support pilots in the continued pursuit of aeronautical skills, both professionally and recreationally. Any Washington Pilots Association member seeking to increase proficiency or regain currency by adding a new rating or certificate by participating in a defined training activity, e.g. instrument training, commercial, tailwheel, mountain flying, rusty pilot.

Scholarship Requirements: Application consists of the following: An essay strictly limited to one page, describing the applicant's objectives in obtaining the scholarship (i.e. professional aviation career; increasing proficiency; regaining currency), and how the scholarship will be used to advance that goal. Essays should emphasize what this training would mean to the applicant, and activities the applicant has participated in with WPA. Documented TOTAL cost of flight training requested and how you will pay for the additional cost of training not covered by the scholarship (make it clear that there are sufficient funds from other sources to complete the training or course of study). Financial need is not a requirement, but is an evaluation factor. Training will be from a qualified school or CFI following a training syllabus.

Scholarship Limitations: Applicants must be a member of the Washington Pilots Association. Training must be completed by April of the following year. April 30, 2023 for the 2022 award.

Other Information: Scholarship funds will be disbursed via reimbursement to scholarship recipients. For reimbursement; applicants must include a copy of receipt for services provided by instructor/agency showing fees paid, flight instructor's certificate, and contact information for flight instructor/agency. Reimbursement applies only to training/activity done after scholarship application is received. Invoices shall be submitted to the Treasurer of the Southwest Chapter of the Washington Pilots Association. The Scholarship Committee may request additional information or documentation. Reimbursement will be upon successful completion of stated training. The amount awarded and completion standards will be presented with the award offer.
